



## **General Greeneye policy on liability and disclaimer**

### **Liability**

With the exception of warranties given in relation to Intellectual Property rights Greeneye will not be liable to a Client for any loss or damage or loss of profits suffered by the Client as a result of any use made by the Client of services provided by Greeneye, save where the loss or damage arises from negligence or wilful default by Greeneye. The liability of Greeneye for all claims made by a Client during a Service Period in respect of any loss or damage are also limited to the value of the services provided by Greeneye during the Service Period of the Agreement in which the cause of the claim occurred.

In cases where services are provided on the basis of individually negotiated contracts we follow the same general principles.

In the case of publications issued more generally we also state that Greeneye cannot take responsibility for errors or omissions.

### **Disclaimer**

Companies researched by Greeneye will be researched to the standards set out in the Guide to EIRIS Research, which we follow or in any successor document which may be subject to amendments from time to time. When Companies are first added to the coverage, some aspects of the research may be delayed by the need to obtain data from companies or others, and completeness of data in particular areas may also depend upon circumstances outside Greeneye's control, such as a Company's willingness to answer particular questions. Greeneye will provide the services agreed with due skill, care and diligence and will use its reasonable endeavours to ensure the accuracy of the information provided. Greeneye will undertake reasonable checks of data that it



acquires from other data providers, but will not be responsible for its accuracy.
